

Today Christians gather worldwide to acclaim Jesus our king. Psalm 93 leads worshipers in acknowledging God's everlasting kingship, while today's other readings invite application of this psalm to Jesus. The Father has prepared his throne from all eternity. He who rules now will

come on the Last Day with fullness of divine authority. All creation acclaims the Son through whom the universe began and in whom lies its glorious final destiny.

Today's first reading admirably serves as the prediction and description of Jesus' enthronement as universal Lord. The "dominion and glory and kingship" that will be his at the Second Coming is already acknowledged within the gathered community, his Church.

Many of us consider kingship outdated and inconsonant with our modern democratic ideals, something to be tolerated only for ceremony and its sense of history. Today's gospel reading shows how kingship continues to apply in the case of Jesus. who ascribes to himself the right to sit on God's own throne. Jesus explains this unique kingship by describing its origin, quality, and meaning. He claims absolute authority over every human being and, therefore, over all earthly rulers insofar as God's creatures. Through his person, words and actions, he proclaims the real God ("the truth"), and so demands a response of commitment and allegiance more absolute than the Caesars of this world could ever dream possible. Jesus' kingship challenges all accepted understanding of the word. He claims absolute power, manifested in rejection, and authority that serves rather than oppresses. "The Lord is king; he is robed in majesty!" (Ps. 93:1).

Today is a day of culmination, the last Sunday of the liturgical year, when we stand united in triumph and joyfully declare: "The Lord is king; he is robed in majesty!" it is a fitting time of year to celebrate Christ's kingship. We experience the glorious and victorious hues of autumn, and it's easy to imagine kingly and triumphant robes of majesty in the fine



golds and fiery reds of billowing leaves; to picture the heavenly banquet in the lush oranges and succulent yellows of a bountiful harvest. If winter brings the experience of death, and spring of rebirth, autumn as aptly epitomizes the glory of completeness and victory. Summer may be filed with exuberance and growth, but it is in the autumn of the year that fullness, awesome in its diversity and integration, points us toward the majesty of the Alpha & the Omega, who was and is, and is to come.
