


CONFIRMATION ENROLMENT WEEKEND

- To highlight the importance of partnership in the preparation programme for Confirmation
- To make the connection between Baptism and Confirmation more tangible by the renewal of Baptismal Promises
- To invite the candidates to make a commitment to personal prayer, to community prayer by attending Mass, to take seriously all the preparation for Confirmation, at school, in the parish and at home and finally to do their best to be kind of person that Jesus would want them to be. We also invite their parents and sponsors to witness this commitment and to promise to help and encourage their child in their endeavours.

The students will be asked to come up to the Altar at the end of the Mass before the final Blessing.



WORLD DAY OF MIGRANTS & REFUGEES

The theme announced by His Holiness Pope Francis for the 2018 World of Migrants and Refugee is "Welcoming, Protecting, Promoting and Integration Migrants and Refugees." In his message, Pope Francis reminds us that "every stranger who knocks at our door is an opportunity for an encounter with Jesus Christ, who identifies with the welcome and rejected strangers of every age..."

A special Mass commemorating the 104th World Day of Migrants and Refugees will be celebrated on **Sunday, January 14th at 1:00 p.m.** at the Good Shepherd Chaldean Catholic Cathedral, located at 2 High Meadow Place in North York. Bishop Kirkpatrick will be the homilist for this liturgy. A reception will follow with a number of dignitaries in attendance. All are welcome to attend!



THE MAGIC OF CHRISTMAS

Today is the Epiphany, the first Sunday of the God's New Year of grace. It celebrates the manifestation (*epiphanos*, in Greek) of Jesus to all the world. In effect, it's the "magic" of Christmas going public, and as such it is best experienced imaginatively.

However, translated, the people seeking and finding Jesus are *magi*, the plural of the Greek *magos*, indicating "people of magic." Not tricksters, mind you, but people humbled and awed by the transcendent, the mysterious, the divine.

They are led by a star, a light shining above and in the darkness. The darkness of human limitations, struggles, and sufferings will not be overcome by this heavenly light. Rather, the light of God promises to lead and guide them (us!) through the maze we call authentic human life.

The magi remind us, too, of how great gratitude sets free great generosity. Their gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh indicate a fullness of life arising from gratitude at God's evident and provident magic among us. The precious gold reminds us to share generously of the marvelous bounty we have received.

Frankincense, with all its pungent aroma, invites us to lift up and offer to God all that is poignant in our lives – the grand as well as the awful. The bitterness of myrrh leads us to an ever more faithful and courageous embrace of life's sacrifices.

Finally, just as the magi were led home by a new route, today's celebration, not unlike Christmas, offers the promise that in God's New Year we will be led to new ways of forgiveness, generosity, reconciliation, vision, justice, peacemaking, and all the etcetera...if only we allow the "magic" of Jesus' starlit coming to lead us.
