

PASTORAL REFERENCES

The Dufferin-Peel Catholic District School Board requires all teacher applicants to submit a pastoral reference when applying for a teaching position. It is the responsibility of the candidate to attend Sunday liturgy, be involved in parish life and contact the parish priest well in advance. Teacher candidates who are attending school out of the local area are also responsible to give the parish priest advance notice. <u>The parish priest cannot complete the</u> form if he does not know the applicant on a personal <u>level.</u>

Updating a pastoral reference is not just a matter of changing the date on the form. The candidate must continue to practice their faith and be an active member of the parish.

THE CANTICLE OF MARY

My soul magnifies the Lord, and my spirit rejoices in God my Savior, for he has looked with favor on the lowliness of his servant. Surely, from now on all generations will call me blessed; for the Mighty One has done great things for me, and holy is his name. His mercy is for those who fear him from generation. He has shown strength with his arm; he has scattered the proud in the thoughts of their hearts. He has brought down the powerful from their thrones, and lifted up the lowly; he has filled the hungry with good things, and sent the rich away empty. He has helped his servant Israel, in remembrance of his mercy, according to the promise he made to our ancestors, to Abraham and to his descendants forever.

The Assumption of Mary, August 15

Mary's assumption into heaven theologically points to what we believed God will do for us. Body and soul, we too will someday be raised to new life in the kingdom of God. She was "the handmaid of the Lord" who agreed that "it be done to me according to your will." Perfect humanity mirrors divinity, and so she has taken her rightful place beside God – as Mother of the Redeemer, as spouse of the Creator, as representative of the Church – as Queen of Heaven
