On <u>Ash Wednesday</u>, **February 26th we** will celebrate Mass at **9:10 a.m., 12:00 Noon** and **7:00 p.m.** with the distribution of ashes. Ash Wednesday is a universal day of fasting and abstinence. It is one of the most popular and important holy days in the liturgical calendar.

Ash Wednesday opens Lent, a season of fasting and prayer and takes place 46 days before Easter Sunday and is chiefly observed by Catholics.

Ash Wednesday comes from the ancient Jewish tradition of penance and fasting. The practice includes the wearing of ashes on the head. The ashes symbolize the dust from which God made us. As the ashes are applied to a person's forehead the words: "Remember that you are dust, and to dust you shall return" are spoken.
