Mass Intentions will be accepted over the phone, by email or the drop-off locked mailbox at the main entrance of the Church during the COVID-19 pandemic. A donation of \$20 for each Mass selected on a specific date. Mass Intentions are offered during the daily Mass, Monday to Saturday (No evening Mass). Please indicate the person's name, the date for the Mass offering, your name and telephone number.



As the parish re-opens, please be aware of the following guidelines. We recognize that they may be awkward/uncomfortable and contrary to our culture of hospitality and community. In working to foster a safe environment for all, we thank you in advance for your patience and co-operation.

- 1. If an individual has a temperature greater than 37.5 °C, the individual must NOT enter the church and should stay home.
- 2. Please wear a mask/face covering before entering the church. Sanitize hands upon entry.
- 3. There will be a designated place to line up outside the church and only one set of doors will be marked as the entrance. Please maintain physical distancing when lining up. A designated Usher will escort you and/or the family to your seats.
- 4. ONLY THOSE WITH A PRINTED TICKET WILL BE ALLOWED TO ENTER. Instructions on how to obtain a ticket can be found on our parish website: <u>https://stjerome.archtoronto.org</u>. Click on "Register for Mass" on the homepage. For those with no access to a computer, you can call the parish office to generate a ticket for Mass. You must pick up this ticket at the designated table before lining up for Mass. Families and those living in the same household may sit together, but each member must have a ticket.
- 5. Please follow all the floor and seat markings to ensure physical distant.
- 6. We ask that people do not hold hands or shake hands during the portion of the celebration of the Eucharist. At the *Sign of Peace*, a nod or bow to others is appropriate.
- 7. Collection baskets will NOT be circulated during Mass. There will be large basket in the gathering space, please drop your donation in the basket when you enter.
- 8. For Holy Communion, ushers will direct people row by row, to ensure proper physical distancing and to regulate the pace of the Communion procession. Please follow the arrows on the floor when joining the communion line and returning to your seat. Directions will be given before each Mass on how to receive the Eucharist. Parishioners will return to their row and seats.
- 9. After the dismissal, the Ushers will direct parishioners to exit row by row beginning with the row nearest the exit. Follow directions provide for dismissal and

departure – exits may be different that those you are accustomed to. Please maintain physical distancing.

- 10. Please departure the church immediately so that cleaning and sanitizing may commence.
- 11. If within 14 days of attending Mass, you learn that you or someone in your family has tested positive for COVID-19, you asked to: a) contact the Ontario Public Health Authority; and b) contact the parish office. Your identity will be kept private other than the Public Authority, and only to ensure that any spread of the virus is contained.
