MANDATORY USE OF MASK/FACE COVERING AT ALL MASSES

In recent days, you may have seen numerous media reports regarding municipalites considering new by-laws requiring the mandatory use of masks in indoor spaces (including places of worship).

City of Toronto: by-law passed June 30 – masks in indoor spaces (including places of worship) become mandatory as of July 7, 2020

Peel Region: by-law passed July 9 in Brampton, Mississauga and Caledon become mandatory to wear masks in indoor spaces (including places of worship).

We recognize that this may be an inconvenience yet we are all committed to carign for our neighbour and those around us. While a number of restrictions have been lifted in recent days, we are still in a middle of a pandemic and need to take the appropriate steps to minimize any potential spread of the Covid-19. So while the Archdiocese of Toronto had highly recommended wearing a maks while in Church and most of you have been doing so, it is now a by-law that we must follow.


- 1. Click on the image "Register for Mass".
- 2. Select the date and time you will be attending.
- 3. Select the number of tickets required for your family members. Please note you will be seated together as a household.
- 4. Please arrive at least 25 minutes before the start of Mass.
- 5. City by-law requires you to wear a mask/face covering at Mass
- **6.** Please bring your tickets or show your mobile ticket on your smartphone.
- 7. If you booked for 4 family members but only 3 members attends and you did not cancel the one ticket, please identify yourself as a family of 4 as you originally booked for.

Please note Mass tickets will <u>NOT</u> be available after 12:00 p.m. on the Friday.

Please call the parish during office hours (Monday to Friday: 9 a.m. -4 p.m.) to cancel your Mass ticket.

If you do not have access to a computer, please call the parish office at 905-455-4260 to reserve your ticket by phone.

GUIDELINES FOR CONFESSION

The Sacrament of Reconciliation is now available. Please make note of the following guidelines when coming to the church for confession.

- 1. As per City by-law, you must wear a mask/face covering in the church.
- 2. Enter through the chapel door beside the St. Joseph Shrine when it is open. After you enter, close the door behind you.
- **3**. Stay behind the plexiglass shield for confession. You may kneel or sit.
- 4. When finished, '<u>knock on</u>' the door you came in for the next person, then EXIT by the door into the gathering space.
- 5. We cannot sanitize between each confession, so we ask you to please sanitize your hands immediately after the confession before you exit the church.
- 6. Leave the church by the side entrance. Say your penance in your car or at home.
- 7. Please do NOT re-enter the Church to say your penance. It has been sanitized for the Sunday Vigil Mass.

You may also book an appointment for Confession by calling the parish office at 905-455-4260.
