FIRST HOLY COMMUNION



The Archdiocese of Toronto has not granted permission for parishes to host a large First Holy Communion celebration. However, many parents have requested to have the sacrament sooner. We are prepared to have each

child receive First Holy Communion individually with their immediate family (same household). Parents were emailed the following information last week:

- 1. "Register for Mass" on the parish website: https://stjerome.archtoronto.org Select your date and the number of tickets for your family (Max. 6)
- 2. Once you have received your ticket confirmation, please email Theresa at <u>culliton@stjeromeparish.ca</u> to confirm your attendance and your seating.
- A reminder to please wear your mask/face covering at Mass. Your child may wear their First Communion gown/suit.
- 4. **NO PHOTOGRAPHY** during or after the celebration. We ask the families to refrain from taking photos in the church and during the celebration. Everyone must exit the church at the end of Mass, so that the church can be sanitized for the next Mass.
- 5. We will acknowledge the children who have received their First Holy Communion at the Mass and their certificate will be given on the same day.



A reminder to all parishioners that you are required to register for Sunday Mass and reserve your spot by obtaining a ticket. You simply go to the parish website:

https://stjerome.archotoronto.org

- 1. Click on the image "Register for Mass".
- 2. Select the date and time you will be attending.
- 3. Select the number of tickets required for your family members. Please note you will be seated together as a household.
- 4. Please arrive at least 25 minutes before the start of Mass.
- City by-law requires you to wear a mask/face covering at Mass
- **6.** Please bring your tickets or show your mobile ticket on your smartphone.
- 7. If you booked for 4 family members but only 3 members attends and you did not cancel the one ticket, please identify yourself as a family of 4 as you originally booked for

Please note Mass tickets will <u>NOT</u> be available after 12:00 p.m. on the Friday.

Please call the parish during office hours (Monday to Friday: 9 a.m. – 4 p.m.) to cancel your Mass ticket.

If you do not have access to a computer, please call the parish office at 905-455-4260 to reserve your ticket by phone.



HUMANITARIAN RELIEF: BEIRUT EXPLOSION

An enormous explosion devastated the city of Beirut, Lebanon, on Tuesday, August 4, 2020, in what the local mayor called "a national catastrophe."

The situation in Lebanon is dire. At least 154 people died in the explosion and 5,000 were injured – those numbers are expected to rise over the coming days. The explosion also destroyed vital food stores and left 300,000 people homeless (representing roughly 12 per cent of the city's population). Five hundred hospital beds, as well as important medical supplies needed for the country's COVID-19 response, were also damaged in the blast.

At this time, we ask the faithful to please donate to the Lebanon relief effort, if they are able.

The Archdiocese of Toronto will send donations to the Catholic Near East Welfare Association (CNEWA), a papal agency with extensive on-the-ground networks in Lebanon. CNEWA staff are currently working to send food, water, medical supplies and hygiene products to Beirut. Spiritual and psychological support will also be provided to those who lost everything in a blink of an eye. Later, CNEWA will rebuild housing and help re-establish those who lost their livelihoods in this disaster.

GUIDELINES FOR CONFESSION



The Sacrament of Reconciliation is now available. Please make note of the following guidelines when coming to the church for confession.

- 1. As per City by-law, you must wear a mask/face covering in the church.
- 2. Enter through the chapel door beside the St. Joseph Shrine when it is open. After you enter, close the door behind you.
- 3. Stay behind the plexiglass shield for confession. You may kneel or sit.
- 4. When finished, 'knock on' the door you came in for the next person, then EXIT by the door into the gathering space.
- 5. We cannot sanitize between each confession, so we ask you to please sanitize your hands immediately after the confession before you exit the church.
- 6. Leave the church by the side entrance. Say your penance in your car or at home.
- 7. Please do NOT re-enter the Church to say your penance. It has been sanitized for the Sunday Vigil Mass.
