A reminder to all parishioners that you are required to register for Sunday Mass and reserve your spot by obtaining a ticket.

You simply go to the parish website:

- 1. Click on the image "Register for Mass".
- 2. Select the date and time you will be attending.
- 3. Select the number of tickets required for your family members. Please note you will be seated together as a household.
- 4. Please arrive at least 25 minutes before the start of Mass.
- 5. City by-law requires you to wear a mask/face covering at Mass
- **6.** Please bring your tickets or show your mobile ticket on your smartphone.
- **7.** If you booked for 4 family members but only 3 members attends and you did not cancel the one ticket, please identify yourself as a family of 4 as you originally booked for.

<u>Please note</u>: Ticket registrations will close at 12:00 Noon on Fridays. New Mass tickets will be posted on the Monday at 12:00 p.m. for the 2-week advance weekend. Please call the parish during office hours (Monday to Friday: 9 a.m. -4 p.m.) to cancel your Mass ticket. If you do not have access to a computer, please call the parish office at 905-455-4260 to reserve your ticket by phone.



Since we had launched our Parish Communication Project on Sunday September 6<sup>th</sup>, we have received positive feedback from our parishioners.

The Parish Communication Project will allow us to livestream our Sunday Masses on the internet for those who are not able to physically attend Sunday Mass. The project also includes a new projector and an updated audio system in the Parish Hall.

It will also aid us in our work in our parish schools. We will not be able to gather the children in the Church or school gyms for mass as we have in the past. With this system we will be able to record a Mass here at the Church and they will be able to watch it in their classrooms at school. It is very important that we do everything we can to maintain our connections to our parish schools.

Total cost for the Parish Communion Project is \$35,000.
