- 1. Click on the image "Register for Mass".
- 2. Select the date and time you will be attending.
- 3. Select the number of tickets required for your family members. Please note you will be seated together as a household.
- 4. Please arrive at least 25 minutes before the start of Mass.
- 5. City by-law requires you to wear a mask/face covering at Mass
- **6.** Please bring your tickets or show your mobile ticket on your smartphone.
- 7. If you booked for 4 family members but only 3 members attends and you did not cancel the one ticket, please identify yourself as a family of 4 as you originally booked for.

Parish Hall is available for seating at a Sunday Mass. PLEASE NOTE that reserving your seat, you may be seated in the Parish Hall. Thank you for your understanding, cooperation and your patience as we try to fit as many parishioners into our worship space as possible.

EVERYONE who attends Mass will receive the **Eucharist**.

New Mass tickets are posted <u>2-weeks in advance of the Mass weekend</u>, every Monday at 12:00 p.m.
