Ash Wednesday begins the season of Lent and is a universal day of fasting (for those between 14 and 65 years of age) and abstinence (for those between 21 and 65 years of age). The Lenten season continues for 40 days and 6

Sundays. During this time, we are called to increase our prayer, to fast on Fridays of Lent and to do works of charity.

Starting Ash Wednesday, and during the weekdays of Lent, we will be allowing 8 people to join us for morning mass. If you would like to attend some of our morning masses please email Msgr. Michael at <u>busch@stjeromeparish.ca</u> and we will add your name to the list. Please indicate the number of people attending with you. To accommodate everyone in a fair way, each day of the week we will rotate through the list, 8 people at a time per mass, and notify you of the dates you will be able to attend. If you cannot make your assigned date, please let us know so that we can add someone else from the list. I know that this is not a perfect solution, but hopefully sometime during Lent the restrictions will be lifted, and we will be able to accommodate everyone every day.
