




4 SIMPLE WAYS TO SUPPORT ST. JEROME'S PARISH

- 2. **BY CREDIT CARD** Contribute to St. Jerome's offertory by credit card on our website: www.stjerome.ca. Select the "Support our Parish". Make sure to **select** "St. Jerome's Parish, Brampton" on the "Parish" dropdown box. You can make a one time or recurring contribution to your parish's offertory or other special funds.
