Marriage Sunday highlights the importance of the sacrament of marriage affirms couples who strengthen our faith community through their witness and complements World Marriage Sunday celebrations that take place across North America.

The Celebration of Marriage Mass will take place on **Sunday, February 13th at 2:30 p.m.** at St. Michael's Cathedral Basilica. Bishop Robert Kasun will preside over this special Mass and all married couples will have an opportunity to renew their vows. Due to social distancing measure, in-person attendance is limited, only couples celebrating their milestone 25^{th} , 40^{th} , 50^{th} , 60^{th} and 60+ wedding anniversaries and one (1) guest per celebrant couple will be able to register to attend (for a total of a group of 3). Other couples, family and friends are welcome to participate in the celebration via Livestream. The broadcast will begin at 2:15 p.m.

Registration will close on February 4, 2021 or when we reach maximum capacity at the Cathedral.

PASTORAL REFERENCES

The Dufferin-Peel Catholic District School Board requires all teacher applicants to submit a pastoral reference when applying for a teaching position. It is the responsibility of the candidate to attend Sunday liturgy, be involved in parish life and contact the parish priest well in advance.

Teacher candidates who are attending school out of the local area are also responsible to give the parish priest advance notice. The parish priest cannot complete the form if he does not know the applicant on a personal level.
