March 2nd is Ash Wednesday. We will be celebrating the distribution of ashes at three Masses that day, 9:10 a.m., 12:00 Noon and 7:00 p.m.

Ash Wednesday begins the season of Lent and is a universal day of fasting and abstinence. The Lenten season continues for 40 days and six Sundays.

The Stations of the Cross will be celebrated on Friday evenings of Lent, <u>after the 7:00 p.m. Mass.</u> During this time, we are called to increase our prayer, fast and abstain from meat on Fridays of Lent and to do works of charity. Even though we begin this Lent with some restrictions still in place, let us pray together that they will be lifted so that we can celebrate Holy Week and Easter together as a parish community.
