NEW INTERIOR CHURCH LIGHTING

After a few months of exploring our options, Msgr. Michael, with the approval of the Parish Finance Committee, has engaged Fortis Electric to address the aging pot lights in our Church ceiling. It is extremely difficult and expensive to replace the bulbs in the older fixtures, so we have decided to replace them with new LED fixtures. Not only are these units more energy efficient, they will improve on the brightness of our current fixtures. This will eliminate the need for on-going maintenance and replacement of bulbs. These new fixtures are guaranteed for 5 years, but in actuality they should last 50,000 hours or more, depending on usage. We will be using some of the Family of Faith donations that we have on deposit with the Archdiocese to fund the project. The work should commence soon and will be done well before Holy Week and Easter.
