In Exodus 18, we find fascinating interaction between in-law, Jethro. Jethro observes Moses

tirelessly resolving disputes among the people from morning until evening. Seeing the inefficiency and burden of this approach, Jethro advises Moses to appoint capable leaders over groups of varying sizes to handle minor disputes, leaving only the major cases for Moses. This system of delegation not only lightens Moses' workload but also establishes a more effective and sustainable method of governance for the Israelites. Moses heeds Jethro's advice and implements a structured system of leadership and organization. This passage highlights the importance of wise counsel, the value of delegation, and the power of collaborative leadership.

Jethro's advice to Moses is also relevant to how we manage and lead our parish. I am in the process of identifying capable leaders for various ministries and committees. I am deeply grateful to all the men and women who have already volunteered for leadership and service roles. Our volunteer Sacramental Coordinator, Ms. Donna Shotwell, recently reported that 42 people have already signed up as catechism teachers. Wow! That's an incredible response!
