PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear Brothers and Sisters.

Continuing from last week's message, I invite you to reflect on the theme of this note as we celebrate the Baptism of our Lord this weekend. Jesus's baptism marked the time of



His entry into His Mission. This year 2025 is going to be a significant year in the life of the Church and our parish. Joining Pope Francis in this Jubilee year we journey together as 'Pilgrims of Hope'. This is also going to be a year of discernment regarding our renewed mission. In this process, we need to assess our strengths and weaknesses, our pastoral goals and aspirations, our priorities and possibilities.

Our parish serves eight elementary schools and two high schools. How can we better share Christ's message with the families of these schools? How can we listen to their concerns, especially those families and young people who may feel disconnected from the church? Many in our community are grieving the loss of loved ones and may not know how to cope. Should we consider offering bereavement ministry?

The cultural diversity of our community is so rich and beautiful; but how can we channel this strength for the work of evangelization? What can we do to help integrate the newly immigrating families and individuals to have a sense of welcome in our parish? What support can we offer to them in these initial struggling years while looking for job, Canadian experience, or emergency landing support? How can we bring *Hope as pilgrims of faith* as we journey together to Christ?

Along with these exciting opportunities, we are also facing some challenges that requires immediate attention. Our youth ministry and sacramental preparation programs are making great progress, but we need more meeting space to accommodate their expanding needs, as well as the needs of other groups and organizations. These are just a few of the important questions we must consider as we move forward. Attached are pictures showing damage to the roof and leaks that have been ongoing. Two roofing companies have attempted repairs, but our building committee has confirmed that the roof has reached the end of its lifespan and cannot be fixed with temporary solutions. The building committee has hired an architectural firm to assess our building, and their report is expected in February. Once available, the committee will review the report and present it to the parish for discernment. This will be an important time for us to decide where we are and where we want to be.

As we move through this process, it is crucial that we hear from you, the people of God. Your prayerful inputs

are essential for the future of our parish. As I often remind you, "Priests come, serve, and leave, but you are the ones who will remain – This is your parish." As you know, I am not an expert in these matters. Your advance knowledge and expertise will be beneficial and crucial to develop sustainable plans for our parish. I hope many of you will step forward as engaged parishioners to pray, plan, and discern both the pastoral and temporal needs of the parish, setting a vision for its future.

In the coming weeks, I will continue to share my thoughts on similar themes. In the meantime, I welcome any suggestions you may have. Please don't hesitate to reach out to me—I genuinely appreciate your input.


