 $\mathcal{J}$  his week, I want to share with you one important suggestion that some of you have

proposed in our pastoral need assessment regarding the use of our parish hall for family and communal gatherings.

Our parish hall primarily serves our ministry groups and organizations. Currently, four major organizations use our hall and meeting spaces: The Legion of Mary, Knights of Columbus, Society of St. Vincent de Paul, and Catholic Women's League. Additionally, we host various parish activities such as choir practice, the Mother & Toddler program, monthly Wednesday Coffee Mornings, Couples for Christ, Youth Ministry, and First Communion and Confirmation preparations.

While ministry needs remain our priority, we also recognize the importance of supporting families during occasions like baptisms, funerals, and First Communions. Many of you have suggested that allowing such use could also bring in modest revenue for the parish, which I see as a proactive and mutually beneficial approach.

After careful consideration, I am pleased to announce that we will accommodate requests for hall use based on availability. However, our priority remains the support of our parish groups and ministries. For security and staffing reasons, we are unable to rent the parish hall after 7 p.m. We are happy to provide the hall for daytime gatherings for parish members. For details on rental agreements, please contact our office manager.

I am also delighted to introduce a new ministry, the "Martha's Ministry," dedicated to managing the hall and kitchen logistics. Daniella Dalla Via and Liza Djiauw will lead this ministry, and I commend their commitment. Please cooperate with their guidance and offer them your support.

In the coming weeks, I will share more exciting pastoral plans inspired by your suggestions. I look forward to your continued input.
