Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ.

when I first arrived at St. Jerome Parish last June, one of the recurring questions I received from Fr. Prem

was, "Are you considering changing the Mass schedule, particularly by introducing an evening Mass on Sundays and weekdays?" My consistent response was, "It is too early for me to make any such decisions; let me first get to know the community." It is possible that Fr. Prem was reflecting the concerns of some parishioners. However, as the incoming pastor, it was my responsibility to first understand the parish and discern the needs of the community before making any decisions.

It is also important to recognize that we are an immigrant community, with hundreds of newcomers arriving constantly seeking new jobs, housing, and settling in according to opportunities and financial capabilities. As a Church, our mission must be to provide access to the sacraments and offer understanding and support to these families and individuals.

As I reflect on my first six months here and observe modest growth in both church attendance and involvement in various ministries, I believe it is now time to make some positive changes regarding the requests that have been raised. It is also worth noting that many of you expressed similar suggestions in our parish need assessment survey.

I am deeply grateful to all the youth and young adults who have signed up as Lectors, as well as to the adults engaged in various ministries such as faith formation, liturgical decoration, the bereavement ministry, sacristans, and all other pre-existing ministries. Your dedication to service has been inspiring.

Currently, on Sundays, we offer only three Masses, with one hour in between each. This schedule provides enough time for a peaceful entry and exit from the parking lot. Therefore, the request for an evening Mass on Sunday seems reasonable, particularly for those who are unable to attend due to work or travel commitments. Additionally, this change will be beneficial for many in our area, as there are currently no evening Masses in neighboring parishes.

In light of this, I have discussed this matter with our regional bishop, Most Rev. Ivan Camilleri, and I am pleased to announce that he has approved our request to introduce an evening Mass on Sundays at 5:00 p.m. This Mass will begin on Sunday, May 4th, 2025. As this is an additional Mass, we will need assistance from all liturgical ministries to ensure its smooth operation. I encourage all ministry leaders to consider this a missionary outreach to those who are unable to attend the Sunday Eucharist, and

to support the efforts required to ensure the success of this new Mass time.

Regarding the suggestion for a weekday evening Mass, I am still discerning this request. Before committing to two daily Masses, it is important to assess both the community's need and the availability of human resources. We serve eight elementary schools and two high schools within the parish boundaries, where we offer Masses and confessions, in addition to caring for three nursing homes within our parish. Therefore, I need to evaluate whether we can establish a sustainable weekday Mass schedule and determine how essential this request is.

That being said, in light of the spiritual emphasis of Lent, we will offer daily evening Masses during Lent. This experience will help us in discerning whether a regular weekday evening Mass is a viable option for the future.

I hope this update helps us all to better understand our common mission and the challenges we face together. There is much planning and preparation to be done as we approach the introduction of the Sunday evening Mass in May. Please keep all those involved in this endeavor in your prayers.

Parishioner will need to bring their candles to Mass on **Sunday**, **February 2**nd and the candles will be blessed and lite during the Profession of Fatih.


BLESSING OF THE THROAT MASS


