# My Dear Brothers and Sisters,



The month of March is dedicated to St. Joseph, the humble and faithful servant of God. Scripture calls him a "just man," and the Church has long sought his powerful intercession and protection. St. Joseph was

entrusted with the care of the Blessed Virgin Mary and Jesus, making him the guardian of the Holy Family and, by extension, the Universal Church.

Pope Leo XIII, in his *encyclical Quamquam Pluries*, reminds us of St. Joseph's unique role: "God appointed him not only as Mary's spouse and protector but also as guardian and legal father of Jesus. As head of the Holy Family, he ministered to their needs and continues to protect the Church today." A century later, St. John Paul II, in *Redemptoris Custos*, urged the faithful to grow in devotion to St. Joseph, emphasizing his example of humble service and trust in God's plan.

# St. Joseph: Patron and Protector

St. Joseph is the patron of many causes: The Universal Church, workers, fathers, families, and those who are dying. His life of silent faithfulness, obedience, and hard work is an inspiration for all. In times of difficulty, we should turn to him, trusting in his guidance and intercession.




