Sacrament of Baptism

Baptisms take place on Sundays, twice a month. Parents must participate in a preparation class before setting a date for their child's baptism. A baptismal registration form is available at the parish office on Sunday. Parents must be registered parishioners, for a minimum of six months, using offertory envelopes.

Sacrament of Marriage

Couples planning to be married must contact one of the priests at least one year in advance. One must be a registered parishioner, using offertory envelopes. A date for the wedding will be set at the couple's first interview with the priest. A marriage course is required. For more information call the parish office.

RCIA

The RCIA program (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults, is a process designed for adults who wish to become Catholic or complete their Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Eucharist, and Confirmation). Candidates meet weekly for lectures from September to Easter, and journey along other candidates, mature Catholics who act as mentors, and the program teachers. My dear brothers and sisters in Christ,



It has been a wonderful experience journeying with 35 pilgrims in the footsteps of St. Paul through Greece. The country's rich history, steeped in mythology and beauty, was both fascinating and inspiring. Greece, the

birthplace of democracy, philosophy, and the Olympic Games, provided a remarkable backdrop to reflect on St. Paul's missionary zeal. His courage in proclaiming the Gospel of Christ in this land of thinkers and philosophers is truly admirable, especially in light of the many challenges he faced.

This past Sunday afternoon, our Martha's Ministry hosted the traditional High Tea event — and what an incredible success it was! The turnout was amazing, with a sold-out gathering that radiated joy and community spirit. Congratulations to all the members of Martha's Ministry, and sincere thanks to our CWL and Knights of Columbus who assisted in making it such a memorable occasion. A special word of gratitude to Peter and Daniela Dalla Via and their dedicated team — Paula, Amanda, Johanne, Catherine, Fidelia, John, Vivek, Joe, Chris, and Mike — for their outstanding work. Organizing a traditional High Tea requires both creativity and meticulous planning. The custom, as you may know, dates back to the 7th Duchess of Bedford, Anna Maria Russell. Because dinner in her household was served late — around 8 or 9 p.m. — she often felt a 'sinking feeling' in the late afternoon. To bridge the long gap between meals, she began requesting a tray of tea, bread and butter, and cake around 4 p.m. Eventually, she invited friends to join her, and thus a fashionable social tradition was born. During the Industrial Revolution, this custom spread among working families as well, becoming a cherished ritual of comfort and connection.

It was heartwarming to see this beautiful tradition brought to life in our parish as a way of strengthening our community bonds. Many participants have already requested that we hold this event twice a year — perhaps in spring and fall. Considering the dedication and effort required, I will leave that decision to the organizing committee.

I am also delighted to share that the event raised over \$4,000 in support of our Renew for Mission campaign. My heartfelt thanks to everyone who contributed in any way. May the good Lord bless you all abundantly.
